

Petros Christoulias

Petros Christoulias was born in 1979 in Chalkis and graduated in 2005 from the School of Fine Arts of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki. He has been working on graphic novels and animation ever since. He's been awarded the Golden "EVGE" (Greek Visual Communication & Design Award) for illustration in 2009, and he's been commended for designing the mascot of the international animation festival on Syros, "AnimaSyros". He was also commended during the 2011 Global Comics Competition in Genova and won the 2013 Best Comic Designer prize in the Comicdom Awards. In 2015 he won the Best Designer and Best Cover Awards for his book "Trenches", as well as the Best Internet Comic Award for "I wander like a bat" during the Greek Comic Awards. In 2021 he illustrated the book «Mosaic», which won three awards during the Greek Comic Awards, including Best BOOK.

He has collaborated with the Greek Ministry of Culture in designing and producing two educational comic books, and with the University of Athens' Dept. of Informatics and Telecommunications in producing a digital tour of the university's History Museum. In 2014 he designed the logo for the SNFCC's summer campaign "Future Library". "Trench" was exhibited at the National Library of Greece, again in 2014, as part of the EU's Europeana initiative.
