

Dr. Mara Simopoulou is an Associate Professor of Physiology-Embryology at the Medical School of the National & Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA), and a Deputy Laboratory Manager of the Assisted Conception Unit at the Aretaieion University Hospital. She serves as an Honorary Associate Professor at University College London in the United Kingdom. She is the Academic and Scientific Director of the first Specialized Training Programme in "Advanced Course in Clinical Embryology", and the Director of the Master of Science Program in "Molecular & Applied Physiology" at the School of Medicine of the NKUA, where she has introduced a specialization on "Clinical Embryology and Genetics of the Preimplantation Embryo". She is a Committee Member of the International Reproductive Health Education Collaboration (IRHEC) and appointed as an ESHRE assessor for the Centre accreditation program for training in Clinical Embryology. She further represents Greece as a basic scientist at ESHRE's Committee of National Representatives. Dr. Simopoulou serves as General Secretary at the new founded Scientific Society of Clinical Embryology and Biology of Human reproduction-Greece and is the newly elected Vice-President of the Hellenic Society of Physiology. She has over 20 years of experience as a clinical embryologist and has authored and co-authored over 100 published papers in peer-reviewed international journals. Her personal mission is to contribute with her clinical, research and academic work to the successful completion of the reproductive journey of the infertile couple.
